Dallas Museum of Art

Founded in 1903, the Dallas Museum of Art (DMA) is housed in the 370,000-square-foot Edward Larrabee Barnes-designed building – the first arts organization in the newly designated Arts District. Today, the DMA ranks among the leading art institutions in the country and is distinguished by its innovative exhibitions and groundbreaking educational programs. Rangers Ballpark in Arlington (Texas Rangers)

Home of the back-to-back American League champions, Rangers Ballpark in Arlington serves as the centerpiece of a 270-acre complex that solidifies Arlington as an entertainment giant in the Southwest. Along with the 49,170-seat open-air ballpark and the Texas Rangers Baseball Hall of Fame in center field, this unique complex hosts a four-story office building, a youth baseball park, a 12-acre lake, and parks and recreation space on the perimeter.

White Rock Lake

Enjoyed by more than 1 million visitors a year, White Rock Lake offers breathtaking views of downtown with easy accessibility to residents throughout North Texas. Nasher Sculpture Center
